

Fashion Portfolio: Creating background using CAD




The Importance of background for portfolio development can not be denied as it has great impact on the portfolio presentation. The various tools & menus provided in Photoshop can be effectively used to create desired effect in background.

Steps In Creating Background Through Collage Work


Step 1: First Open Photoshop \rightarrow Go to File Menu \rightarrow Open \rightarrow then open Image File.



Step 2: Go to Layer \rightarrow Doable Click on first layer \rightarrow New Layer \rightarrow layer properties \rightarrow Change layer Name, Layer Color & Unlock Layer.








Step 4: To Fill Black Color in Layer 1

- Press D Default Color Plate to get black in foreground Research
 Background color.
- Press Ctrl + Backspace to fill black color in layer 1.



• Now in this layer option window, two layers are visible - Leaf layer & Layer 1 in Black.




Move Layer 1 to bring leaf layer in upper position to work with





Step 5: Reduce opacity of leaf layer to 62%.







Step 6: Open another New Leaf Image \to Use Magic Wand Tool \to Select leaf \to & Drag Leaf on working Layer.






Step 7: Go to Edit Menu \to Use Free Transform \to & Set Leaf work position by compressing in vertical direction.






Step 8: Open New Designed Fashion Images.






Step 9: Use Magnetic Lasso tool \to Create Selection \to Move tool \to Select Image & drag on working layer.



Step 10: Repeat step 9 to bring another fashion image on working layer.




Step 11: Same work is repeated until all the Images are drag into working layer.→ Then Set all fashion images in different positions as shown below.




Step 12: Use Text tool \rightarrow write text "THEMATIC FASHION PORTFOLIO". Double click on the text layer \rightarrow layer style \rightarrow Add effect on text \rightarrow Drop Shadow, Bevel & emboss \rightarrow then Set Values to get desired effect.




Creating Drop Shadow Effect in text:

Step 12: Both the text layer & fashion sketch layer are grouped in set 2 and save the file. All the three background layers are grouped in set 1 as shown in layer window. Layers in set 1 are of green colors & all the fashion sketch layers in set 2 are of pink color.
